



The International Research Center for Renewable Energy (IFEED) was established in 1999 as a non-profit research organization under the support of the UN in Dedelstorf for the purpose of research, promotion and implementation of new developments in the field of regenerative energy, especially in rural areas.

Since 2003, the research center was located in Sievershausen and since 2010 in Wierthe / Vechelde, Germany. Branch offices are located in Haryana State, India, and in Columbus, Ohio State, USA.

- IFEED has a seat in the Council of Renewable Energy, the "World Council for Renewable Energy" (WCRE), and was recognized in EURO SOLAR as a "Centre of Excellence" for promotion of renewable energies.
- Management of the International Council for Sustainable Land Management and "International Council for Sustainable Agriculture" (ICSA) are integrated with IFEED.
- There are close cooperation with "Club of Rome", UN, EU, TREC, and other organizations from Africa, Asia and Europe.
